## Passing the Torch A Life Worth Living 2 Timothy 2:1-13

## Introduction

When Paul writes this letter, he is back in prison at Rome. However, this time Paul is not just under house arrest; we find him chained in a cold, damp Roman cell with no hope of getting out alive. (4:3)

- 1. Paul pens this final letter to \_\_\_\_\_, which many consider as his last will and testament.
- 2. Paul knew Timothy would need boundless strength to endure in his work as pastor of the church in
- 3. Paul is probably considering his own life and legacy as he reaches out to give Timothy vital tips that make your life worth \_\_\_\_\_.

# I. Be Strong In Grace

### III. Learn To Persevere

17.Paul's third piece of advice is found in verse 3, "You, therefore, must \_\_\_\_\_\_ hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ." (2 Timothy 2:3) Paul offers three images of perseverance in verses four through seven.

- 18.First, Timothy must adopt the attitude of a \_\_\_\_\_\_ who plans and expects that hardship will be a part of the mission.

### IV. Remember Your Freedom in Christ

- 23.In verse 8, Paul writes, "\_\_\_\_\_\_ that Jesus Christ, of the seed of David, was raised from the dead according to my gospel."
- 24. In his letter to the Romans he wrote, "Jesus Christ our Lord, was born of the seed of David according to the flesh, and declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the \_\_\_\_\_\_ from the dead."
- 25. The only eternal hope in the world is the hope \_\_\_\_\_\_ offers.

Our freedom from life's addictions and vices rests upon the redemptive and rescuing work of Christ on the Cross.

#### Conclusion

Verse 11 is one of five "\_\_\_\_\_\_ sayings" found in the Pastoral epistles.

The statements made in the faithful saying are all

- If we die with Him, we shall live with him.
- If we endure with Him, we will reign with Him.
- If we deny Him, He will deny us!
- If we are faithless, He remains faithful.
- 26. There are many people right now who need faith and hope for their \_\_\_\_\_.

Without faith, it is impossible to please God! (Hebrews 11:6) Faithful servants will always choose a life worth living!
