## Walking in the Spirit: Part 2 Galatians 5:22-23

# Introduction

Last week we began a mini-series on walking in the Spirit. Walking in the Spirit is God's alternative to serving him by simply focusing on his commandments and trying to keep them by our own moral will-power. As we walk in the Spirit, He gradually and progressively transforms and empowers us to serve God effectively.
