#### A Miraculous Birth Matthew 1:18-25

### Introduction

The birth of Jesus is far from being a myth. It is an event deliberately placed in history. The apostle Paul tells the Galatians, "But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law." (Galatians 4:4 NKJV)

- 1. God came down in\_\_\_\_\_ form.

- 19. First, God did it to alert us that Jesus was the promised
- 20. A virgin birth would obviously be a greater\_\_\_\_\_ than the miraculous births of previous key players like Isaac, Moses, or Samuel.
- 21. The second way Jesus' unique conception and virgin birth furthered God's good plan for us was to provide \_\_\_\_\_\_ for the whole human race.

- 22. Joseph is told in 1:21 to name the Child "Jesus" because he will \_\_\_\_\_\_ his people from their sins.
- 23. Our need for salvation is rooted in the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God.

- 26. This doesn't mean that God's love cancels out his righteousness and justice, but because he cares about us so much, he provides a way to pay for our sin and guilt so that he can accept us without compromising his moral
- 27. The heart of biblical theology is the good news that God's love for us provides \_\_\_\_\_\_ as a blameless substitute for us. His death on the Cross pays for our sin and guilt.

# III. God's Perfect Provision

# Conclusion

32. The birth of Jesus is God's personal offer to reconnect with Him spiritually for the purpose of eternal . It is an offer that requires your

personal response.

33. Our sin and guilt before God are spiritually . It is so lethal that only the death of his Son, Jesus, can remove it.

God has provided us with plenty of evidence to know that Jesus is his Son and that he is ready and willing to save us. You can know and mentally agree to all this and still die in your sins. Unless you personally entrust yourself to Jesus, the Great Physician, to remove the sins that will destroy your life, he will be of no benefit to you. The final decision is up to you!
